Peace Camp
Creative Conflict resolution workshops for school age I and school age II classrooms. Students will work on building conflict resolution skills and strategies through role-play and other class interactions.

School-age children will be planting and harvesting a vegetable gardening in an Easton Community Garden plot.

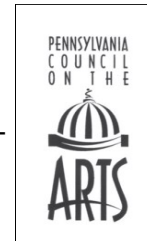


“Emerging Young Artists: The Sounds of Vision”

Summer Camp 2011 is a collaborative arts program which includes Easton Area Community Center, Arts Quest and local artists as partners. Our summer camp program will begin with the “Art in All of Us, ...Inspiring Children Around the World , Pen Pal Program”, art exhibition. This year our School age II classroom exchanged art with students in Romania.

This summer students in **1st—5th grades** will be engaged in a variety of activities that foster creative expression through multiple learning experiences. Our focus will be on cultural diversity, science, environment, technology and social studies.

Students will participate in Mixed Media, Photography, Eco-Art and Global Arts workshops. In addition students will tour the Urban Environment Art Installations, visit an art gallery and attend a theater production.

This summer our school age students will visit the Art of Urban Environments, an outdoor exhibit of multimedia sculptures in historic Easton. Artist Brandon Ballengee will engage students in an educational and a fun “bug” workshop. Students will go on a hike, make butterfly nets, and a bug graffiti.
